Culture is one of the leading and powerful components of the people's lives and instruments for combating against discrimination, intolerance, infringement of human rights and inequality. Cultural field always reflects transparently the society needs, expectations, as well as obstacles people are forced to struggle. Moreover, culture, both tangible and intangible, is a central element for reaching the inclusive, plural, open and sharing societies in Europe and beyond. The project aims to spread and strengthen the valuable joint voice of artists that includes the enormous potential of intercultural dialogue, and to support & promote the exploration in

culture field in order to create the uniqueness space for creation, enhancing of social inclusion, sharing European values and call for world peace against the war.

Through the project activities and due to the joint actions of partners the artists and cultural actors will have the opportunity to strengthen and create new connections, create new multicultural pieces of Art that mirror multicultural view on world not limited with borders. One of the leading tasks is to attract and increase the society's attention to the respect of human life, raise the importance of human rights, equality, solidarity, individual freedom and freedom of views, peace, tolerance and respect of other cultures through the creation of platform of cooperation and exchange of practices, experience, inspirations, etc. without any prejudice.

**Proposed project activities:**

- Creation of space/platform for cultural actors for cooperation and creation;
- Conduction of workshops and networking for close cooperation of cultural actors including the people in-need and with disabilities;
- Active cooperation with Ukrainian cultural and creative professionals for the support of Ukraine and European values, as well as pursue priorities proper to the culture field through the conduction of campaign against inequality, war, terror, prejudice to national minorities and people in-need;
- Dissemination campaign with the active use of social media and digital instruments for popularisation of artists' works, progress and main objective of the project, including the development of content on the constant basis during the project implementation period and after it (posting of works of culture workers for sustainable promotion of stakeholders and their outcomes);
- Development of Action Plan and Collection of Best Practices in Culture Sphere with the true stories of cultural actors – representatives of target groups through the research of multiple natures of cultural practices, collaboration with target groups in their real life conditions, etc.;
- Culture for Health and Peace – the exchange of experience and knowledge including practices related to the culture in call for peace and health. This capacity building programme will provide the opportunity to promote the relevant burning and crucial issues of society. The outcome – the creation of multicultural collection of works in different culture fields (Art, Photography, Video, Sculpture, etc.) and the organisation of exhibition in offline and online (through the digital instruments) formats;
- Signing of agreement between partners for future cooperation, sustainable promotion and support of cultural actors in Europe and beyond;
- Creation of the short movie/video of the culture diversity and common values with the call to action for peace and sustainable safety well-being.

**Such activities and the project in general provide the great input in the promotion of culture and support of cultural organisations, as well as independent cultural actors. The mission of the project is to call the attention of society to the culture as the fundamental building block of the common peaceful future without war.
