



Invitation to Open Training Session #1

Agriculture in focus: connecting water, risks, and financing for resilience

The REGILIENCE+ team is pleased to announce the first Open Training Session (OTS) of its *Contributing to Climate Resilience* series, focusing on agriculture as first topic. As agriculture faces increasing climate-related pressures, the session will explore how the sector's resilience can be strengthened by considering water management, risk reduction, and financing as complementary dimensions.

After a brief introduction to the overall objectives of the series, we will examine how these elements can be considered together to support more sustainable agricultural systems, and how they are reflected in different solutions and practices.

We will then present experiences from regional and local initiatives, including examples from Spain, Italy, and France, showcasing climate information tools, adaptation strategies based on crop selection and water resources management and restoration, and financial mechanisms supporting farmers in managing climate-related risks. We will conclude with a panel discussion and presentation of the main takeaways, highlighting the importance of integrated approaches to resilience in the agricultural sector.

Opportunities to interact and exchange with the speakers will be provided to encourage a fruitful exchange and make the session a valuable learning experience.
